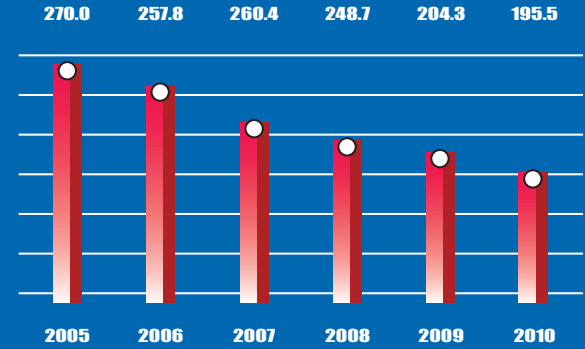
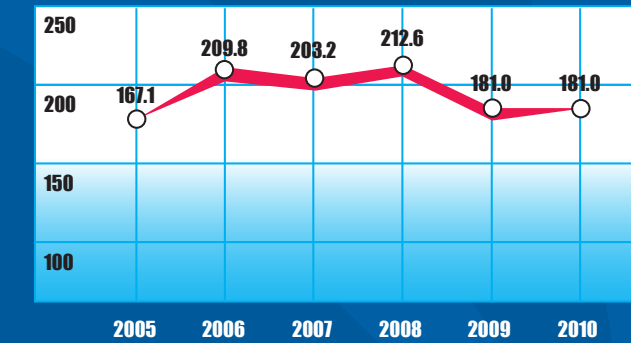

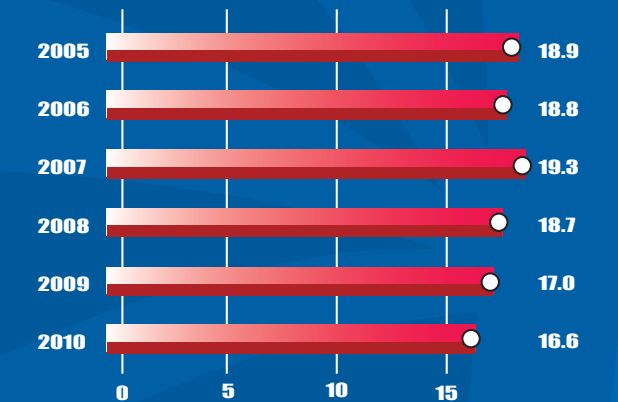

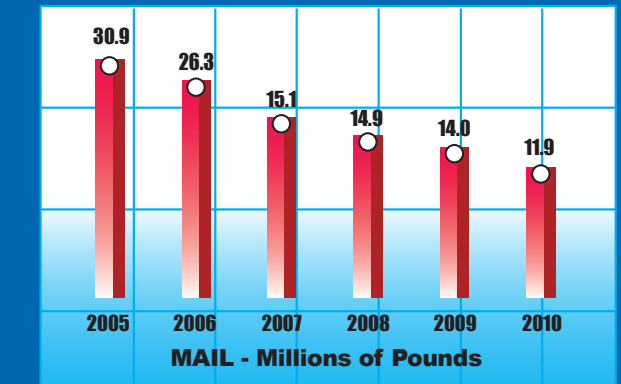
AIR CARGO - Millions of Pounds
