Cancun Has More Spirit!
Spirit Airlines Announces Non-Stop Service From Tampa to Cancun, Mexico with Fares Starting at \$89*

FORT LAUDERDALE, Fla. (June 27, 2005) – Spirit Airlines today announces new, daily, non-stop service between Tampa International Airport and Cancun, Mexico beginning on November 10, 2005. Tampa International Airport currently has no non-stop service to Mexico.

This flight will originate in Atlantic City, New Jersey offering members of the South Jersey community convenient one-stop service to Cancun and the Riviera Maya.

“We are delighted to offer Tampa and the west coast of Florida international service to Cancun, Mexico,” said Barry Biffle, Chief Marketing Officer of Spirit Airlines. “As the leading low cost carrier to the Caribbean and Latin America, we look forward to meeting Tampa’s demand for convenient, quality, low fare service.”

“This is great news for the Tampa Bay community. Bringing new international service to the community does not happen overnight. Spirit has been working closely with the Airport and we appreciate all of their hard effort and willingness as a partner to bring this new service to Tampa,” said Louis Miller, Executive Director of Tampa International Airport.

In addition to this new service to Cancun, effective November 10, 2005, Spirit will significantly increase its service to the Caribbean and the Bahamas. As previously announced, Spirit will be adding non-stop service to Nassau, Bahamas from both Orlando and New York’s LaGuardia Airport as well as new non-stop service to Montego Bay and Kingston, Jamaica from Fort Lauderdale. Effective 11/10/05, 24% of Spirit’s schedule will be serving this region.

Spirit currently offers non-stop service to Cancun from both Detroit and Fort Lauderdale with convenient connections from Atlantic City, Chicago/O’Hare, NY/LaGuardia, Providence/Boston Area, and Washington, D.C./Reagan National.

Introductory fares between Tampa and Cancun start at \$89* each way for travel November 10, 2005 through February 7, 2006, blackout dates November 11/18-11/30/05 and 12/15/05 – 1/8/06. Fares must be booked on spiritair.com by July 31, 2005.
