Subject: Restricted Aeronautical Activities

PURPOSE: To establish procedures regarding restrictions on certain aeronautical activities at Tampa International Airport.

GENERAL: In compliance with Tampa International Airport's rules and regulations, the Authority limits certain aeronautical operations or activities in the interest of safety and compatibility of air traffic.

PROCEDURE: All categories of aircraft other than airplanes or helicopters are prohibited from aeronautical activities at the airport. The Authority recognizes those aircraft which fall under the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) definition of airplane or helicopter. All airplanes and helicopters must be FAA certificated, registered and properly equipped for flight activities to and from the airport.

Aircraft fabrication or construction, experimental flight, equipment demonstration, aerobatic flight, air shows and maintenance flight checks are prohibited at the airport except by the prior written approval of the Authority.

All aeronautical activities at the airport and all flying of aircraft departing from or arriving at the airport will be conducted in conformity with applicable provisions of the regulations promulgated by the U.S. Department of Transportation.
