PURPOSE: To guide the overall management and operations of the Authority’s general aviation airports.

LEGAL CONSIDERATION: Section 4(2) of the Hillsborough County Aviation Authority Act states that “[t]he Authority has exclusive jurisdiction, control, supervision and management over all airports in the County” Section 6(2)(1) states that the Authority may “[adopt] and amend rules, regulation, and policies reasonably necessary”

POLICY: The Authority will manage and operate the general aviation facilities at Authority airports in a manner that ensures Tampa International Airport operates in a more efficient and less congested fashion and using best management practices to ensure that appropriate revenue is generated. The Authority will provide a high level of service to users of the facilities and will ensure that the airports and facilities are operated safely, securely, and in compliance with applicable federal, state and local requirements. The Board will adopt rules and regulations, pursuant to legal requirements, governing the use of each of the general aviation airports. The Chief Executive Officer will ensure that the rules and regulations are reviewed at least every three years and will recommend changes to the Board, or recommend that no changes are necessary.
