

To our Tampa Bay community, our TPA passengers and our employees,

As we continue to grow and develop our facilities and air service this year, I'd like to reinforce Tampa International Airport's commitment to enhancing our people, our planet and our collective prosperity.

Our airport sustainability program has made significant strides toward our triple-bottom line through the implementation of our Sustainable Management Plan (SMP), dubbed Legacy of Environmental Actions for our Future (LEAF).

Striving to achieve our quantitative goals by 2021, TPA aims to:

- Reduce our greenhouse gas emissions by 5% on a per passenger basis
- Reduce our potable water usage by 10% on a per passenger basis
- Reduce, reuse and recycle to reduce the solid waste disposed by 10% on a per passenger basis
- Reduce our electricity consumption by 3% on a per passenger basis

Our SMP outlines initiatives from strengthening our community partnerships to reducing waste and energy consumption. We recycle 1,100 tons of solid waste from our Main Terminal and airport operations annually and more than 24,000 tons of Master Plan-related materials have been recycled to date. We have installed 15 electric vehicle charging stations for our passengers, as well as 4 new spaces installed for our internal employees. We've also saved more than 441 million gallons of potable water through reclaimed water use since 2009.

Our goal is for TPA to be an industry leader in sustainability. Through the active engagement of airport management, staff, tenants and community, TPA sets the best practice standards for the industry making a positive impact on our community and our environment.

I hope you'll join me in helping this Airport reach its sustainability goals and carry out our mission in ensuring TPA is an integral part of our community and our global connections for generations to come.
