


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Noise Monitoring Office Update

Fall/Winter Weather Patterns


- This time of year, winds are predominately from the north:
 - The last 60 days
 - 75% Northerly winds
 - Can give the impression flight patterns have changed





Airport Flow

Actual Wind Direction Dictates Airport Flow



Airport Flow (November and December Combined):

75% North Flow

25% South Flow

Same Period 2022:

82% North Flow

18% South Flow

East Runway Closures

- Runway 1R/19L:
 - Closed November 29th ,2023, for various runway maintenance activities
 - Closed December 15th ,2023, for various runway maintenance activities



West Runway Closures

• Runway 1L/19R:

- Closed November 28th,2023 for various maintenance activities.
- Closed December 13th,2023, for various maintenance activities.






Scheduled Runway Closure Data

- November thru December Closure hours
 - Runway 1L/19R 12 hours
 - Runway 1R/19L 14 hours
 - Runway 10/28 24 hours

East Runway Traffic Increase (January 4-8, 2024)

- On January 4, 2024, a section of Taxiway C (primary north-south taxiway) on the east side of the Airport had to be closed for pavement repairs.
- The loss of this section of taxiway resulted in the FAA shifting runway use to minimize impacts to the National Airspace System and to maximize safety.
- The taxiway was reopened on the evening of Monday, January 8, 2024.
- The closure resulted in ~40% of the airports traffic operating on/off the east runway during this period.

Location of Pavement Repair

19L



- The closure required aircraft to cross two runways to get to the departure runway for north flow and to cross two runways after landing in a South Flow.
- This shift and slowdown in aircraft movement resulted in the FAA increasing operations on/off the Airport's east runway




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Upcoming FAA Tower Glass Replacement

FAA Tower Glass Replacement

- During the month of June 2024, the FAA will be replacing the glass of the Tower cab:
 - This timeframe is subject to change
- At this time, the FAA has advised they do not anticipate impacts to their operations as a result of the tower glass replacement
- In the event of a safety issue with the glass replacement, the FAA may establish a temporary tower on the airfield, which would increase flight operations on/off the Airport's east runway







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Upcoming Runway Maintenance Projects

West Runway Asphalt Shoulder Repairs and Slab Replacement

- Over the next ~12 months, there is a project to repair/replace asphalt on the shoulders (sides) of the Airport's west runway.
 - The exact period the runway will be closed for this work is not yet known:
 - The closure of the west runway is expected to be ~30 days (subject to change)
 - This closure will result in most aircraft using the Airport's east runway
- We will communicate more definitive information as that information becomes available.
