

Overview

- Total Complaints: 267
- Total Complaints (same period 2015): 77
- Air Cargo Compliance: 98%
(458 of 468 air cargo compliant operations)
- Commercial Pilot Request Compliance on Runway 19L/1R: 99.8%
(25,476 out of 25,521 commercial compliant operations)





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
Noise Office Proactive Initiatives

Proactive Initiatives In Partnership with the FAA

- Initial planning discussions on operational changes due to Taxiway J construction focused on potential 24/7 changes on the east runway.
- Limited temporary operations on the east runway for Airside A air carriers from 10am-6pm.
- Shifted widebody cargo operations back to the west runway, in compliance with the airports Preferential Runway Use Program.
- Further reduced usage of the east runway on weekends and some holidays.

Pilot Engagement


- Meetings underway with air carrier Chief Pilots.
- Effective education strategies for flight crews.
- Developing relationships for post construction changes.



North Flow Departures – Overview

Overview


- Commercial aircraft follow a standard departure procedure.
- After departure, aircraft follow a slight westerly (left) departure track.
- Standard departure procedures are established by the FAA and were last updated in 2011 due to Runway change in order for departing aircraft to maintain same historical track.



Enhanced Online Complaint Filing

- Residents create a profile with current household information which is stored for future use.
- Once registered, residents file a noise complaint in three steps.
- Enhanced portal will provide near real-time flight tracking capabilities.
- Specific deviations on or off of Runway 1R-19L will be posted to the airports website approximately 72 hours following each day.
